A 2001 graduate of Humber College's Performance program, Jefferson Guzman has been acting professionally in Toronto for almost five years.

Jefferson's most recent television credits include a supporting role on DOC and a guest appearance on Queer as Folk. His current commercial credits include Mott's Clamato, Kokanee, and a series of Pepsi ads.

On stage, Jefferson toured with Theatre Direct Canada in two Dora nominated shows: Andrew's Tree and I Met A Bully On A Hill (Outstanding Production - TYA). He also played the lead role in two new plays written and directed by Sky Gilbert: Heliogabalus: A Love Story and The Secret Life Of Haddon McKenzie. Jefferson will play the lead role in Bad Acting Teachers written and directed by Sky Gilbert at Buddies in Bad Times Theatre in the spring of 2006.

Jefferson has also written two plays that premiered in Toronto at the Rhubarb Festival at Buddies in Bad Times Theatre. His articles have been published in Canada and translated into Portuguese for publication in Brazil.

Recently he wrote, directed and produced a short film entitled M-F that premiered in Toronto at the Canadian Filmmakers Festival. It later screened at the Sudbury International Film Festival and has just received a worldwide distribution deal.
